Social insurance registration

THE Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security of the People's Republic of China recently released "Interim Measures for Participation in Social Insurance System by Foreigners Employed in China." It specified that foreigners working in China should register for Chinese social insurance system and pay the full fees on time.

Those foreigners who have worked in China before October 15, 2011, and meet the qualifications of participating in social insurance should pay the social insurance from October 15, 2011. Those who register and pay the insurance between October 15, 2011 and December 31, 2011 needn't pay the overdue fine. Those

who register after January 1, 2012, will be required to pay the overdue fine. Additionally, foreigners who started working in China after October 15, 2011, should register and pay the social insurance from the month they begin to work.

For foreigners who have not registered before, their employers need to go to the social security bureau to register with their employees' passport, work permit, foreign expert certificate or foreign resident journalist certificate and work contract. Those with permanent residency need to provide their permanent residence certificate. Those approved will get their social security number and social security card.

Q: My friend wants to take part in the HSK, but he is now in Xi'an on business and will not be able to register for the exam on the scene. Is there any other way to register for the exam?

A: Your friend can register for the exam online or by sending a mail. He needs a bank card with online payment function and a digital photo if he wants to register for the exam online. There are four steps: 1) Register online and submit personal information; 2) Sign in by using the registered name and code and submit the digital photo; 3) Log onto the page of exam reservation and payment, reserve the exam and pay the fees; 4) At a fixed time, go to the examination venue with his identification (passport or ID card), after being checked, collect the admission ticket. The website of HSK is www.hsk.org.cn. If your friend wants to register for the exam by mail, he needs to send the copy of his ID card, resume (including Chinese and English name, gender, nationality and date of birth), address and two photos (35mm by 45mm) to the registration place. Candidates should also remit the exam fees to the registered place through post office. Registration by telephone is not accepted. Candidates could collect their admission tickets on the scene on the day they take part in the exam. — Jiading District Foreign Affairs Office

Q: Some of my friends will visit Shanghai at the end of February. Do they need to stay in foreign-related hotels during their trip in China? — Maosen

A: Your friends are free to stay in any hotel they choose, and the foreign-related hotel just means the service standard, rather than a restriction. As a foreign-related hotel, it should be able to provide the service catering to foreigners, such as international phones, international TV channels, signs and menus in both Chinese and English, and



managers should be able to speak English. All these services may provide more convenience to your friends from overseas. Also, regardless of where your friends stay, they need to register at the nearest police station after checking in at the hotel. — Jiading District Public Security Bureau
